Inspired by the outstanding employment service given by Sally Summers who worked for Saunders Shoes for over 70 years, this special award recognises <u>individuals</u> who have demonstrated exceptional long service to a Wairarapa business during their <u>employment</u> with that business.

Judges will be looking at individuals who have been nominated by their employers because they have played an instrumental role in helping the business reach significant growth, a milestone or an achievement. They will be individuals who are well respected within their sector and have shown loyalty to both their customers and their company.
